
## Fitting & Instructions - Bath Pop Up Waste & Overflow

## **IMPORTANT NOTES**


- Please ensure installation is undertaken by an experienced Plumber, as to ensure compliance with all Council and Local Authority requirements


## **Installation Steps:**

Disassemble the product according to the exploded diagram as above.


1. Assemble the fittings according to the picture 1.




2. Install "A" ensuring it slides down into the body "G"




3. Assemble the rubber according to the picture 3.



4. Install "K" through the screw "L" onto "G" tightly.




5. Check for leaks



6. If there exists water leakage, then disassemble the product and back to step 1.

Pls apply a generous bead of a suitable bathroom silicone sealant around the bottom rim of "D" if necessity.



## Attention:

This waste is designed for a bath with a maximum thickness of 16mm.

In order to adjust flow rate in compensation for differing bath thicknesses the Screw length 'A' and locking nut 'B' may have to be adjusted.
