This Agrément Certificate Product Sheet⁽¹⁾ relates to Easy-Trim Lead R, a polyester coil coated aluminium sheet with an adhesive backing, for use as waterproofing in flashing applications on pitched roofs, as an alternative to lead flashing.

Technical Specification

1 Description

- 1.1 Easy-Trim Lead R is a polyester coil coated aluminium sheet, fully covered with butyl adhesive on the lower surface, protected by a release paper.
- 1.2 The rolls are available with the nominal characteristics of:

Roll length⁽¹⁾ (m) 5.0

Rollwidth⁽¹⁾ (mm) 150, 300, 450, 600

Thickness (mm) 1.42 (smooth) and 3.2 mm (corrugated)
Weight of roll (kg) 1.7, 3.5, 5.5 and 7.5 (smooth and corrugated)
Colours Red, Black, Brown, Light grey and Lead grey

Finish structured, corrugated or smooth.

- (1) Other widths and lengths are available to order.
- 1.3 Ancillary items for use with the product, but outside the scope of this Certificate, are:
- Easy-Trim Bitumen Primer for use on unstable and uneven substrates
- Easy-Trim Lead S silicone sealant for jointing.

2 Manufacture

- 2.1 The product is manufactured from polyester coil coated aluminium, covered on the lower face with butyl adhesive and a release paper.
- 2.2 As part of the assessment and ongoing surveillance of product quality, the BBA has:
- · agreed with the manufacturer the quality control procedures and product testing to be undertaken
- assessed and agreed the quality control operated over batches of incoming materials
- monitored the production process and verified that it is in accordance with the documented process
- · evaluated the process for management of nonconformities
- checked that equipment has been properly tested and calibrated

• undertaken to carry out the above measures on a regular basis through a surveillance process, to verify that the specifications and quality control operated by the manufacturer are being maintained.

3 Delivery and site handling

- 3.1 The product is distributed in boxed rolls marked with the size, colour, product name, number of rolls per box and the BBA logo incorporating the number of this Certificate.
- 3.2 The product should be stored upright on a smooth, clean, dry surface, under cover and protected from sunlight.

Assessment and Technical Investigations

The following is a summary of the assessment and technical investigations carried out on Easy-Trim Lead R.

Design Considerations

4 Use

- 4.1 Easy-Trim Lead R, when designed and installed in accordance with the relevant parts of BS 5534 : 2014, BS 8000-0 : 2014 and BS 8000-6 : 1990, is suitable for use in flashing applications, such as side abutments, stepped flashings, dormers and chimneys to provide a weatherproof junction.
- 4.2 Where the product is likely to come into contact with potentially corrosive chemicals (such as acid, alkali, oil or solvent), a test on the product should be conducted before proceeding. If any doubt arises, the Certificate holder's advice should be sought.

5 Practicability of installation

The product can be installed by roofing contractors experienced with this type of product.

6 Weathertightness



The product, when incorporated into a roofing system designed and installed in accordance with conventional good practice, will adequately resist the passage of moisture to the interior of the building and so contribute to the roof satisfying the requirements of the national Building Regulations.

7 Properties in relation to fire



- 7.1 Samples of Easy-Trim Lead R, when tested in accordance with BS 476-3: 2004, achieved an A rating for surface spread of flame.
- 7.2 In the opinion of the BBA, the product therefore achieves an AA / low vulnerability classification as defined in the documents supporting the national Building Regulations.

8 Strength

The product will resist normal impacts associated with installation and use.

9 Maintenance

There are no maintenance requirements, other than a regular visual check for damage. Damaged areas can be repaired by following the Certificate holder's instructions prior to completing the roof covering.

10 Durability



The product, when subjected to normal conditions and areas of use, will have a service life in excess of 20 years.

Installation

11 General

- 11.1 Installation of Easy-Trim Lead R should be strictly in accordance with the Certificate holder's instructions, the relevant recommendations of BS 5534 : 2014, BS 8000-0 : 2014 and BS 8000-6 : 1990 and this Certificate.
- 11.2 The product is worked the same way as lead flashing, by installing and working in any direction using a mallet or roller, or by hand. It can be cut with a sharp knife or scissors.
- 11.3 Cutting and folding, including when working with a lead dresser, can be carried out at a minimum temperature of 5°C.

12 Procedure

- 12.1 Surfaces must be clean and dry, and any loose material removed to ensure proper adhesion. Uneven substrates should be primed using Easy-Trim Bitumen Primer⁽¹⁾.
- (1) The performance if this material has not been assessed by the BBA and is outside of the scope of this Certificate.
- 12.2 The release film on the back of the product should be left in place until the final shape and position has been determined. Once positioned, the release paper is removed, and the product dressed into the brickwork or applicable surface.
- 12.3 Joints should have a minimum overlap of 100 mm. Where top edges are exposed, Easy-Trim Lead S silicone sealant⁽¹⁾ is applied to prevent ingress of rainwater behind the flashing and protected with a cover flashing, unless it is turned into the joints of the brickwork.
- (1) The performance if this material has not been assessed by the BBA and is outside of the scope of this Certificate.

13 Repair

Damage to the product can be repaired easily prior to the installation of slates or tiles by patching and sealing the damaged areas. Care must be taken to ensure that the watertightness of the roof is maintained.

Technical Investigations

14 Tests

Tests were carried out and the results assessed to determine:

- ash content
- dimensional checks
- weight per unit area
- tensile strength and elongation at break on controls and following heat ageing and UV ageing
- resistance to tear
- water absorption
- water vapour transmission
- effect of heat ageing
- resistance to UV exposure and stability

- · dimensional stability
- low temperature flexibility on controls and following heat ageing
- peel strength from support on controls and following heat ageing.

15 Investigations

- 15.1 The manufacturing process was evaluated, including the methods adopted for quality control, and details were obtained of the quality and composition of the materials used.
- 15.2 An assessment was made of fire test data to BS 476-3: 2004.
- 15.3 A survey of known users was carried out to assess the performance in use.
