
## **Flexibles:**

- 1. Before starting work, turn mains stop cock and/or boiler or immersion heater off and drain the system.
- 2. Loosely fit the tap connector end to tap shank (or cistern input valve when fitting WC cistern).
- 3. Offer other end of flexible to supply pipe and mark where to cut supply pipe.
- 4. Remove flexible, cut supply pipe where marked and deburr ends. Best done most cleanly with Tube cutter and Deburr brush.
- 5. Re-attach tap connector end (with washer supplied) loosely to begin with, having first wrapped PTFE tape around the thread.
- 6. Place nut and olive over cut end of supply pipe, slide nut and olive up pipe to connector.
- 7. Tighten nut by hand, having first wrapped PTFE tape around the thread.
- 8. Tighten nuts, do not over tighten, turn on water gently and check all connections for leaks.



## **ISOLATING VALVE**

When needing to replace tap or washer, simply insert screwdriver or small coin in slot in isolator and give 90° turn to stop water flow. On completion turn back so that slot lines up with water flow.

- A TWISTED
- B SQUASHED
- C STRETCHED
- D KINKED
- E BENT AT SHARP ANGLES (ESPECIALLY NEAR THE ENDS)
