




Malmo Base & Tall Units Installation Instructions

GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS


REMEMBER

- Handle product with care.
- When drilling walls, check first for hidden pipes and cables.
- Use safety eyewear when drilling.
- Keep all small parts away from children.
- If the product is over 20 kg (see packaging), 2 people are required to carry and install the unit.


IMPORTANT NOTES

- Ensure all cut outs for plumbing are carried out prior to installation.
- All exposed edges of timber need to be treated or sealed using PVA.

Fixing and fittings supplied




Tools Required (not supplied)

- Pozidrive Screwdriver
 - Power Drill & 5mm Bit
 - Spirit Level
 - Hammer
 - Tape Measure
 - Pencil


Step 1 - Wall Fixings

- Decide on the height of the Tall Unit and, using a spirit level, draw a horizontal line to work to (1).
- Mark out the internal dimensions of the unit making sure the plates are within the internal dimensions of the unit by 2-3 mm (2).
- Using a Power Drill along with the Wall Plugs and Screws provided, fix the plates in place.
- If the wall is not solid, you will need to use your own fixings. Ensure that they are adequate to support the total weight of the Unit as stated on the packaging.



Step 2 - Hang Unit

- Hang the unit on the Wall Mounting plates (3).
- Remove the Cover Caps. (4)
- Level the unit by adjusting the screw on the bottom of the Hanging Bracket. Use a spirit level (5).
- Once level, tighten the screw on the front of the Hanging Bracket to bring the Unit to the wall (6).
- Only Use a handheld screwdriver to tighten brackets to the wall



Step 3- Attaching the doors

- Please refer to door installation instructions provided.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **On Gloss White furniture please ensure all protective material is removed prior to fitting**
- **This furniture is made of wood and has a water resistant finish. It should not be left wet**
- **The quality of the finish is best maintained if it is wiped with a dry cloth after use.**
- **It should only be cleaned using a soft damp cloth followed by a dry cloth**
- **Do not use bleach or any abrasive cleaner.**
