

Installation instructions – Wall brackets

- 1. Take great care when handling this shelf. Whilst every effort has been taken to remove sharp edges, the material by nature may be sharp. We recommend wearing safety gloves.
- 2. Check the package for completeness and any transport damage before installation commences. Installation of the shelf is acceptance of quality.
- 3. Check the mounting wall is vertically level. (This will ensure the correct drainage of water if the shelf is to be used to hold a basin.) If the wall is not level, then you may need to shim the mounting brackets to ensure they are level during the installation process.
- 4. This shelf needs to be anchored securely to a structural substrate, brick / breeze wall, or the timber inside a stud wall, using appropriate fixings.
- 5. The shelf is not supplied with wall fixings. It is the installers responsibility to ensure the brackets are full supported and anchored safely.




Overhead view of shelf brackets fixed to a wall with a tiled surface, note the anchors fixed to the substrate.

Guidance on wall fixings


Each installation will be different therefore wall fixings need to be...

- Made of a corrosion resistant, high tensile material, like stainless streel capable of supporting150kg load.
- Have a diameter of maximum 8mm.
- Be long enough to penetrate securely into structural substrate.
- Have a washer with an outer diameter of 14mm and inner diameter suitable for the accompanying bolt.
- If in any doubt seek advice from a qualified professional

- 6. The shelf has lateral adjustment in its fixing points.
- The brackets should ideally be set at no less than 250mm taken at the centre of each bracket, the maximum adjustment is 464mm.




7. There is a 0-15mm adjustment if the brackets do need recessing to contact any structural substrate, if you need more than 15mm then you will need to bring the structural substrate forward with rigid cement board or similar that will not compress under load.




View from underside of the shelf with brackets and optional towel rail

8. If the final surface finish of your bathroom is soft and can easily be damaged then the mounting brackets should ideally be anchored directly to a structural substrate, wall, plaster, or timber inside a stud wall. Do not surface mount the brackets on top of PVC cladding or similar soft material.




9. When mounting the brackets to a stud wall with a non-compressible multi-board or similar then ensure that each bracket is mounted to a vertical and horizontal structural timber.

Non compressible multi-panel bracket mounting




10. Combinations of the two aforementioned installations can be done so long as the brackets are fully supported and anchored to a non-compressible material.

Dot and dab plaster board bracket mounting




Plaster board to stud wall bracket mounting.




11. Once the brackets are adequately level and secured to the wall, unpack the shelf(A), turn it upside down on to a soft surface.

- 12. A suggested tap hole position is scored on the underside of the shelf. Check the positioning of your basin and tap, and mark as required, be mindful about the spout reach of your chosen tap to ensure it adequately overhangs the basin.
- 13. Drill the required diameter holes as recommended by your tap and basin supplier using a diamond hole saw.
- 14. Position the eight 'T' bolts (D) by sliding them into the 'C' section fixing rail, fix the towel rails (G) using 4 x M8 nuts (B) and washers (C).



15. Using the remaining 'T' bolts (D) and 4 x M8 nuts (B) and washers (C) fix the shelf into position, refer to basin and tap instructions to proceed with installation.



Cleaning and Maintenance guidelines

- 1. Metallic objects (including steel scorer's) and ceramic objects should never come into contact with the basin as they may damage the decorative surface.
- 2. Clean your shelf regularly with a damp cloth and mild detergent.
- 3. Hair dye and some cosmetics such as mascara, lipstick may cause slight discoloration and must be cleaned up immediately.
- 4. Do not allow any solvents to come into contact with this product.
- 5. Remove any limescale with a domestic spray limescale remover.


