

#### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Warning: This unit is heavy. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Installation shall be carried out exactly according to the manufacturers instructions otherwise a safety risk can occur if incorrectly installed.

#### Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly. All packaging can be recycled.




• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

• Safety note: This unit must be secured to a wall using the brackets supplied.


• From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.





Only follow steps 22 and 23 if you are fitting two carcases next to each other.




5mm drill-bit

Ensure units are flush with each other and that both units are level, then clamp them together.

Drill through the 2 holes highlighted with a 5mm drill bit into the adjoining side panel of the other unit.


**NOTE:** To reduce the possibility of any breakout, we recommend the use of a small piece of waste wood placed behind the hole while drilling.




1. Mark the centre of the Brackets for drilling into the wall.

2. Drill into the mark-holes in the wall using an appropriate drill-bit. The screws and plugs are not supplied as they need to be the correct type to suit your wall.


3. Drop the key-hole part over the Screw, ensure the protruding parts are against the grooves in the bracket, and tighten the screw.


4. Slide the plastic cover over the bracket.

**NOTE:** Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.




