



Care and maintenance


- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

Only follow steps 22 and 23 if you are fitting two carcases next to each other.






Ensure units are flush with each other and that both units are level, then clamp them together.

Drill through the 2 holes highlighted with a 5mm drill bit into the adjoining side panel of the other unit.

NOTE: To reduce the possibility of any breakout, we recommend the use of a small piece of waste wood placed behind the hole while drilling.




WARNING!

In order to prevent overturning this product must be used with the wall attachment devices provided!






Leave the screws sticking out from the wall by about 3cm



- 1. Mark the centre of the Brackets for drilling into the wall.
- 2. Drill into the mark-holes in the wall using an appropriate drill-bit. The screws and plugs are not supplied as they need to be the correct type to suit your wall.
- 3. Drop the key-hole part over the Screw, ensure the protruding parts are against the grooves in the bracket, and tighten the screw.
- 4. Slide the plastic cover over the bracket.

NOTE: Take care when drilling the wall that you do not drill into any pipes, wires etc. If in doubt, consult an expert.
