### Important - Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

- Warning: This unit is heavy. Please lift with care.
- Check you have all the components and tools listed.

• Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

• Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

• Installation shall be carried out exactly according to the manufacturers instructions otherwise a safety risk can occur if incorrectly installed.

### Care and maintenance

• Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do no use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor (use opened out unit carton).

• Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly. All packaging can be recycled.




• We do not recommend the use of power drill/drivers for inserting screws,

as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.


• Safety note: This unit must be secured to a wall using the brackets supplied.

• This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal centre.





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


## **Door Assembly**



Note: The following steps show the Door being fitted onto the Right side of Single Carcases. To fit the Door to the Left side fit the hinge plates to the Left end panel.


Consider the unit/s the Door is being fitted to, and follow the indicated step.







Note: The following steps show the Door being fitted onto the 2250 carcase. The same method applies to all configurations.



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**a:** Push the Hinge onto the front part of the Hinge Plate. The recess at the bottom of screw B goes into the slot in the Hinge Plate.


**b:** Keep the Hinge FLAT against the Hinge Plate as you slide it across as far as it will go. Tighten screw A.

**c:** The Hinge must be flat against the Hinge Plate prior to any adjustment.


**d:** The Hinge must NOT be AT AN ANGLE to the Hinge Plate when assembled.


This would indicate that the recess at the bottom of screw B had not located in the slot in the Hinge Plate and the Hinge would not be secure. Remove the Hinge from the Hinge Plate and then

re-assemble being careful to follow instructions a-c.




### **Door Installation**





Fix the soft-close fitting to the **top hinge** on the Door.

Push the hooks on the soft-close fitting into the holes on the hinge and then firmly press down to click into place.



## **Door Installation**

Adjust the door if needed.

### a: Height adjustment.

Loosen screws A on hinge plates and move door up or down as required. Re-tighten screw A.

### b: Forward and Back adjustment.

Loosen screw B on hinge plate and move door in or out as required. Re-tighten screw B.

#### c: Sideways adjustment.

To move door 'out' loosen screw C. To move door 'in' tighten screw C.

#### d: Soft close adjustment.

To adjust the damping force on the soft-close fittings, turn towards the '+' to increase and towards the '-' to decrease.
