Fixing Instructions

- 1. Open pack(s) and store flat in a pile for a minimum of 72 hours in the room in which they are going to be used. Shuffle the pile daily to ensure that all boards adapt to room conditions.
- 2. Fit Cladding battens around the perimeter of the area to be clad. Then fill in with further cladding battens spaced at maximum centres of 400mm and running at 90° to the cladding.
- 3. Fix each piece of the cladding to every cladding batten with either clips or panel pins.

IMPORTANT

- Traditional Cladding must be sealed immediately to avoid moisture absorption.
- Use wood varnish, wood stain or paint suitable for timber.
- Only fix with cladding clips or panel pins <u>Do not use adhesives</u>.
- Do not fix in recently plastered rooms because of the high moisture content.
- Please ensure the ends are treated / sealed to prevent moisture ingress.
